TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All container charges are subject to change by the relevant Port, charges above are applicable as of the date you received this document.

Customs Entry charges are inclusive of the UK Port Exam fee.

Entry fee includes up to 3 commodity codes, thereafter is charged at £3 per additional code.

Deferment fee if applicable, charged at 3% of deferred value or minimum £38.00 per entry.

Above charges exclude further examinations if selected due to the nature of cargo and will be passed on at cost from authorities.

Charges exclude any other documents/services required such as Port Health CVED/CED, Peach applications.

All documentation including Licenses and preference certificates must be provided prior to vessel arrival to avoid delays.
